# STUNNING *Kitchen* by LAKEVILLE KITCHEN & BATH

When interior designer, Katy Goodrich, owner of Rynwood Designs in Huntington Bay, was selected by the owners of a new home being built in Laurel Hollow, it was agreed to create an understated look with elegant design elements. It was also agreed to keep an eye on costs, but one that would never be noticeable.

While the home was being built by Black Oak Builders, Goodrich and the home owners had a vision of creating a light and airy Hamptons beach house look in the kitchen.

The many subtle design elements created by Goodrich, and brought to life by Danny Weisz of Lakeville Kitchen & Bath, resulted in a kitchen which includes numerous details that reflect the owners' desire for subtle, understated, casual elegance.

Beach and ocean colors were created using soft white cabinets, pale blue walls and a pale blue kitchen island, custom color matched by Lakeville Kitchens and Plain & Fancy Cabinets.

Crown molding that ends below the ceiling and the use of stacked doors for the upper cabinets contribute to the light, airy look.

Traditional mullion glass cabinet doors flank the farm sink side of the kitchen. Decorative table legs are forward set on this wall, to break up the solid line of the cabinets and add a furniture look to the cabinets. These same decorative table legs are used

again on the island; a design element that gives a cohesive touch. Elliptical glass cabinet doors flank the concealed Sub-Zero side by side.

The Viking range side of the kitchen features open shelves with arched valances and bead-grooved backs. Bead grooved cabinet sides are also used and work to contribute to the desired look of casual elegance. ■
