Three generations of the Sirlin family have guided Lakeville to its present day as a leading wholesale supplier of kitchen and bath cabinets. For over 70 years, customers both large and small, have depended on the service and reputation of Lakeville for their cabinet needs. 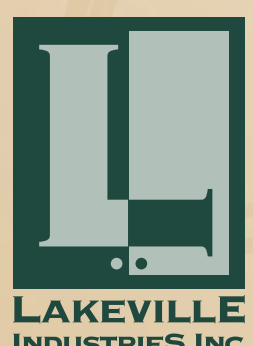
